## WELL DONE!

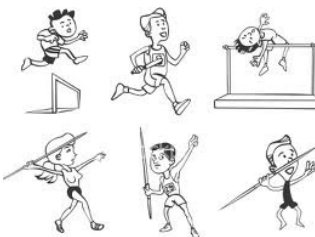
Ross Cody - who won the Leinster Area Writing Competition.
